Growing & Gaining Momentum

Last year was another year of tremendous growth and evolution for Pink Lemonade Project.

In 2022, your support enabled us to take the time to strengthen, better integrate, and offer new and longtime programs and services to individuals affected by breast cancer across 42 counties in SW Washington and Oregon.

We reinstated our hallmark retreats. We also invested in screenings with un/underserved individuals in direct partnership with healthcare organizations to expand screenings for the first time. We launched the region’s only Spanish-speaking support group. We expanded other valuable programs to raise awareness about breast health and breast cancer across communities and continued to provide vital financial assistance, mentors, and emotional, psychological, and community support.

At the conclusion of 2022, we served 2,572 individuals and families, an increase of 47% over 2021. In addition, we grew new partnerships and collaborated with many area healthcare systems and other community-based organizations to learn about other needs of breast cancer patients, and how best to support them.

Your vote of confidence in us and in our work also led to record fundraising in 2022. Our revenue grew to \$949,473, a 42% increase from 2021. You, our loyal donors, remained by our side, as we developed new relationships and added many new friends and family who are passionate about our mission. I hope this annual report gives you a better understanding of our financials and represents your investment in our work.

Compassion, community, and collaboration have been important values in our collective commitment to ultimately save more lives and promote better quality of life.

I share my heartfelt gratitude to you—our donors, healthcare partners, community partners, volunteers, board members, and staff for your outpouring of generosity, time, and talent to educate, empower, and support more people affected by breast cancer.

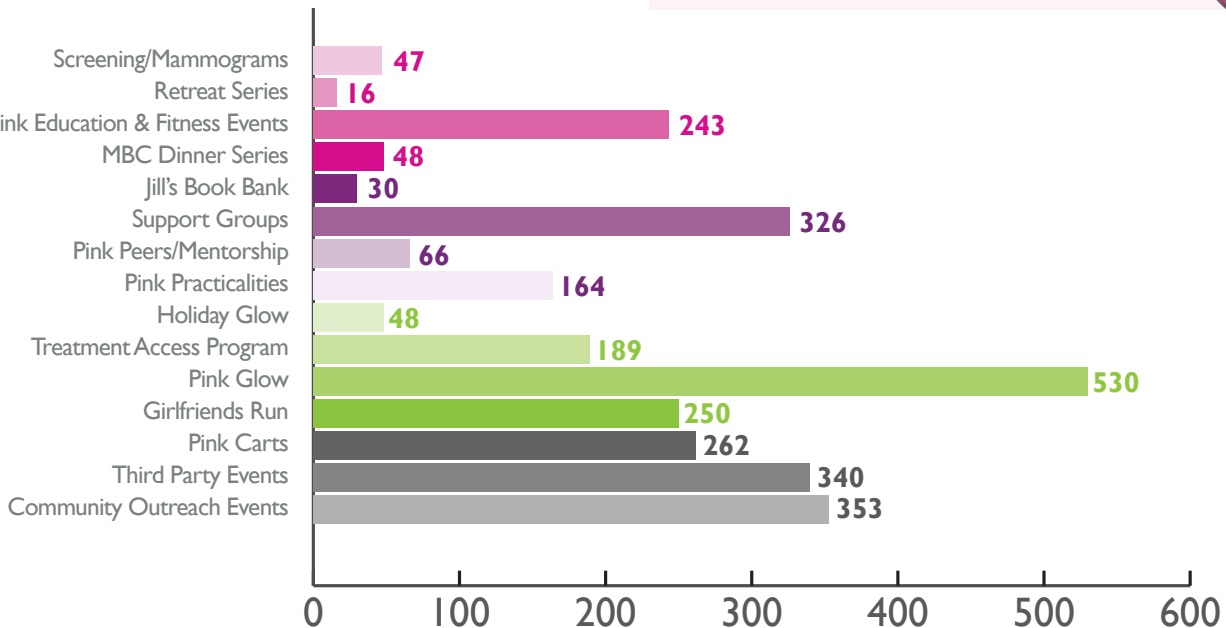


Participants Served by Program/Event

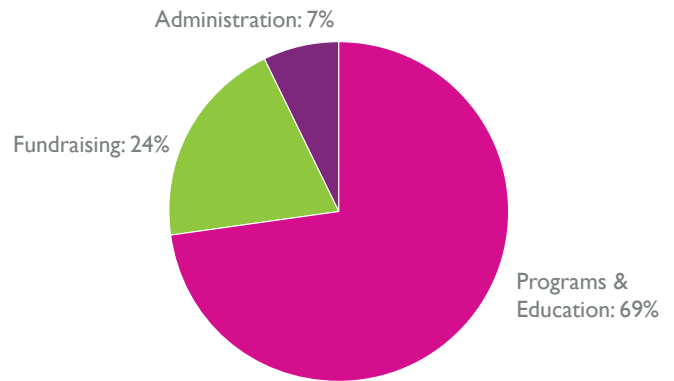
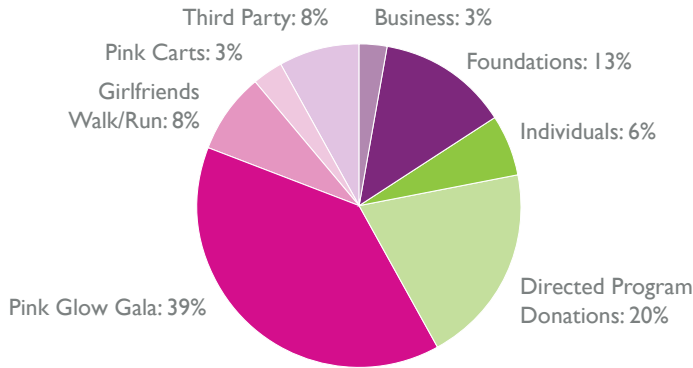
