MBC, also known as “Stage 4,” is breast cancer that has spread to other parts of the body.

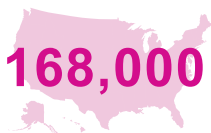

Programs and events are developed and overseen by an advisory council of patients living with metastatic breast cancer and a medical advisor.

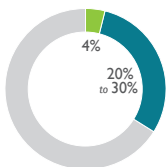
