

## FACTS:



**1 IN 7 WOMEN** in the Pacific Northwest will likely develop breast cancer

**20%-30% OF THOSE DIAGNOSED EARLY** are likely to experience a recurrence



**10%-15% OF CASES** are due to family history

## CURRENT CHALLENGES:

- **Screening rates** in Oregon and Washington have dropped by 11%.
- **More younger women** are being diagnosed with aggressive forms of breast cancer.
- **Underserved and rural populations** are experiencing more later-stage diagnoses and death.

**Research shows that early detection and access to care can significantly improve health outcomes.** Community connections, nutrition, and exercise can reduce new breast cancer diagnoses, and breast cancer recurrences.

## Why Pink Lemonade Project exists:

**By partnering with healthcare and human service organizations,** Pink Lemonade Project stays informed about current breast cancer data, gaps in care, and emerging needs.
